IN THE CNMI. THESE SPECIAL CONSERVATION ZONES PROTECT
OUR FISH, CORALS, AND INVERTEBRATES. THEY SERVE AS SAFE HAVENS
FOR MARINE ORGANISMS TO GROW AND REPRODUCE IN AREAS FREE FROM
FISHING PRESSURE.

CERTAIN ACTIVITIES ARE RESTRICTED WITHIN THESE MPAS, AND EACH AREA HAS
UNIQUE RULES. MAKE SURE YOU ARE AWARE OF THESE RULES BEFORE YOUR NEXT
VISIT. REMEMBER, THESE CONSERVATION AREAS ARE FOR ALL TO ENJOY. PLEASE JOIN
US IN PROTECTING THESE PRECIOUS RESOURCES.
